



Notice of Race

GERRY BROWN MEMORIAL **REGATTA** **Sunday, April 25, 2010**

GENERAL

This Notice of Race (NOR) covers the Baltimore Area Boardsailing Association, Inc. (BABA) Series, Race 1. A memorial to a past BABA founding member who succumbed to cancer. All proceeds and donations will go to The Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center at Johns Hopkins.

HOSTED BY

The Baltimore County Sailing Center at Rocky Point Park, Essex, MD

VENUE

This race will be held at The Baltimore County Sailing Center at Rocky Point Park, Essex, MD

Take Baltimore Beltway (I-695) to Exit 36 for Route 702 South. Proceed south on Rt. 702 and continue with its merge with Back River Neck Road. Stay on Back River Neck Road for 2.3 miles then make left onto Barrison Point Road. Make right onto Rocky Point road and drive until you enter the park. Parking is on your right and it's a short walk.

GOVERNED BY

The Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix B, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, Rules of The International Formula Windsurfing Class Association, the rules of any organized and represented classes; the Notice of Race, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) the Sailing Instructions (available at registration), and the Official Notice Board.



WIND MINIMUMS

Official races will not be started in winds less than 8 mph for Formula and 3 mph for all others. The Race Committee (RC) will be the only and final judge to determine competitive racing conditions.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, participants must complete the registration process.

DISCIPLINES & COURSES

Course racing will be the primary discipline. The courses will be described in detail at the skippers meetings.

FLEETS, CLASSES, & DIVISIONS

The BABA competition will be held in the following fleets and classes:

- * **Formula Fleet:** *Formula 31*
- * **Longboard Fleet:** *Women's Limited 7.5,*
Men's Limited 7.5,
Open Unlimited
Hybrid
- * **Novice Fleet:** *Novice and Junior (16 and under).*
